TERRA DI TUTTI FILM FESTIVAL - SECOND EDITION
Bologna, October 10 - 11- 12, 2008

Bologna, July 28th, 2008. From October 10th to October 12th, 2008 at the *Cinema Lumière* in Bologna will be held the second edition of *Terra di tutti Film festival: southern world documentaries and social cinema exhibition*.

During the three days of the festival, 30 documentaries, selected among 100 short/medium films submitted by independent video makers from the five continents, will be shown. These works are documentaries and animations that may well open spaces of information breaking the official media censorships, offering a straight sight from the South of the world. The festival is promoted by COSPE and GVC, non governmental organizations engaged since over 30 years in international cooperation toward development.

Sustainable development and fighting poverty in rural sector are the topics selected for this second edition. The video proposals submitted report the history of men and women who are resisting to the expropriation of their own lands. Territories on which the personal identity is built, kept as memory while in exile, as richness to defend or place where traditions are threatened of extinction. Images from African metropolis to the sierras in Latin America, dawn to the slums in Asia. And, furthermore, stories about the uncertain future of street boys and girls and pictures of life in shantytowns. Within the set-up in which they live, friendships grow, people meet, rights are defended. In Senegal, in Brazil, Bolivia, Lebanon, Kosovo, Palestine, Iraq, Rumania.

This edition of the festival will be enriched by many side events: workshops and debates with directors, producers, film makers, journalists and, on Saturday 11, the Palestinian rappers' group *Ramallah Underground* that will perform in the TPO - Via Casarini, Bologna.

Terra di tutti Film festival collaborates with the exhibitions of social cinema from the south of the world held in Cordoba (Spain), Maputo (Mozambique), Rosary (Argentine) and La Paz (Bolivia) and is as well partner in the European network of festivals on the same subject *Tierra de Todos y Todas*. The network involves Spain, Portugal and Hungary.
